

## **AISL Incentive Program 2009 -2011**

---

The objective of Australian International Shooting Limited's Incentive Program is to reward those shooters, who meet the requirements, for their achievements. The grant program consists of a combination of Competitive Program Grants, Incentive Grants, and AISL Gold Grants.

The AISL HPPMC will administer this program.

Grant program announcements will be made in the AISL's official publication "AISL News" and on the AISL's website at [www.ausshooting.org](http://www.ausshooting.org) Athletes qualifying for the AISL Grants will be sent grant applications and instructions.

### **COMPETITIVE PROGRAM GRANTS**

In the Olympic events conducted at the 2010 World Shooting Championship, Competitive Program Grants will be awarded to the top three finishers in the open category. This grant is to help offset costs associated with training for and attending the 2010 World Shooting Championships. Competitive Program Grants will be awarded in the following manner:

<i>1st Place</i>	<b>\$750</b>
2nd Place	\$400
<b>3rd Place</b>	\$150

To be eligible for the Competitive Program Grants, an athlete must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a current member of an AISL Member at the time of the competition and grant payment.
2. Have a PQS in a 2012 Olympic event in accordance with Australian International Shooting Limited's Policies and Procedures, at the time of payment.
3. Be current with ASADA's Athlete Location Form. In the event the athlete is not registered in the ASADA Out Of Competition (OOC) pool, the athlete must complete all paperwork and be registered with ASADA before disbursement of the grant.
4. Have not transgressed AISL policies and/or Athletes Code of Ethics

Athletes are only eligible for a Competitive Program Grant in one event at the 2010 World Championship. Competitive Program Grants not disbursed by the above criteria will be returned to general revenue.

### **INCENTIVE GRANTS**

An athlete may receive an incentive grant when meeting the following criteria:

1. Winning an individual event medal in any of the four ISSF World Cups in a year.
2. Winning an individual medal the junior category at the 2010 World Shooting Championships in an Olympic event.

<b><i>Gold</i></b>	\$2000	\$1000
<b><i>Silver</i></b>	\$1500	\$750
<b><i>Bronze</i></b>	\$1000	\$500

3. Winning a 2012 Olympic Quota: (2010-2011) \$2000

### **AISL GOLD GRANTS**

The AISL will award Gold grants based on individual athlete performance at the 2010 World Shooting Championships in the open category.

Grants will be awarded in the Olympic events only as follows:

<b>1st Place</b>	<b>\$4000</b>
<b>2nd Place</b>	<b>\$3000</b>
<b>3rd Place</b>	<b>\$2000</b>

AISL Gold Awards are limited to one award per athlete.

ALL Grants are conditional on availability of funds.
