The specific performance range will be determined on an event basis and dependent upon assessment against criteria including (but not limited to) depth of field, competition format and/or ranking system.</p> <p>“Benchmark Competitions”: competitions which are of significance to Australia’s international sporting image. “Capability”: assessed by reference to defined sport specific criteria and process.</p> |
| International Class Athlete | International senior competitor in an Individual event or team event at benchmark competitions and considered capable of retaining or progressing this level of | |
| Developing International Athlete | Athlete with the capability to achieve at least International Class Athlete status within 1-3 years. | |
| Potential International Athlete | Athlete with the capability to achieve at least International Class Athlete status within 4-7 years. | |
