

AISL Team Selection Policy

28th March 2009

AISL may select athletes to compete at the ISSF World Cups, ISSF Shotgun World Championship, IPC/ISCD Events and other International Competitions, in accordance with the following criteria.

1. AISL may consider sending Athletes of differing performance levels to the events listed above, with selections taking into consideration the following sequence of nomination as listed at 1.1-1.2. In all cases Team positions will depend on Team size restrictions for whatever reason and will be at the absolute discretion of the HPPMC. Athletes must be a member of the relevant AISL Member body as defined by the constitution cl. 4.3
 - 1.1. Athletes who are members of any AISL HP Squad or ISD/ISCD PPP Squad
 - 1.2. Athletes who have achieved from the ranking events (listed in cl. 3), a Performance Qualification Score (PQS) within six months of the team nomination to the event may, at the discretion of the AISL selection panel, be invited on a self funded basis to gain experience. The Performance Qualification Scores are listed on the AISL website (HP policies page)
2. The AISL will publish an Athlete Ranking List taking into account scores (not including finals) obtained over a rolling 12 month period at the events listed in cl.3 and other suitable events as determined by the HPPMC and published within reasonable lead times.
3. RANKING EVENTS:

4. Where there is more than the required number of athletes eligible for consideration for selection into a team, the Selection Panel ('Panel') may also consider the athlete's international performance history.
5. In all cases, the athlete must be able to demonstrate to the National Head Coach that they are maintaining a training regime and where deemed necessary attend such camps and control competitions as determined by the National Head Coach.
6. Funding of selected athletes for travel is set out in the AISL Team Travel Funding Policy
7. The Panel will comprise the;
 - 7.1. The relevant AISL National Head Coach
 - 7.2. The AISL Member Body's HP Representative
 - 7.3. AISL Head Coach
 - 7.4. High Performance Manager
8. Invited self funded members will be required to sign and abide by the Team Agreement and any such reasonable conditions as published from time to time. Confirmation of acceptance of a position (which may be MQS only) on a team must be made within seven days of the mail being deemed to have been received. All costs must be paid to the AISL one month prior to departure.
9. The above program is also dependent on availability of funds and subject to change which will be published on the AISL website.

10. Any incident or act related to doping in breach of IOC, WADA, ASDA, ISSF, ASC, and AISL policies will result in the immediate withdrawal of the athlete(s) from the team and suspension subject to investigation and any appeal through the appeal mechanisms in place under the applicable protocols.

11. APPEALS PROCESS

- a) Where a competitor reasonably considers in all the circumstances that his/her non selection or non nomination *to a team* has occurred because the Panel has failed to follow these Criteria, the appeal procedure is detailed in the document entitled Appeals Process; a copy of which may be downloaded from the website www.ausshooting.org or by request from the office.

Note:

- ***Performance Qualification Scores are not a travelling score and therefore does not mean a shooter (who has performance qualification score/s) will travel, it is however a prerequisite.***

- ***For those athletes wishing to gain or further their international experience a list of open international events may be found on the ISSF website calendar page. Performance Qualification Scores may only be attained at events identified as overseas International competitions where there are more than 6 different countries competing and more than 15 athletes in the event in which Performance Qualification is being sought.***
- ***This selection policy does not apply to nomination for the:***
 - *ISSF (Full) World Championship,*
 - *Oceania Continental Championships,*
 - *Commonwealth Shooting Federation Championships,*
 - *Commonwealth Games,*
 - *Olympic Games and*
 - *Paralympics Games where separate policies will be issued.*
