

# AISL Team Travel Funding Policy

---

Athletes selected to a squad, will be funded in accord within the plan agreed with the HP Coach and manager.

Athletes selected to a Team, in accordance with the relevant selection policy, on a self funding basis will be reimbursed as shown in the table below:

<i>a</i>	<i>A Medal at an ISSF World Cup or Championship</i>	=	<i>100%</i>
<i>b</i>	<i>PQS Score at an ISSF World Cup or Championship</i>	=	<i>100%</i>
<i>c</i>	<i>A Finals Placing at an ISSF World Cup or Championship</i>	=	<i>90%</i>
<i>d</i>	<i>A finish in the top 25% at an ISSF World Cup or Championship</i>	=	<i>80%</i>
<i>e</i>	<i>A finish in the top 30% at an ISSF World Cup or Championship</i>	=	<i>50%</i>

Subject to available funding.

The funding level refers to airfares, entries and accommodation only.

Where possible, AISL will announce the Teams approximately 4 months ahead of competition.

AISL will book all flights following discussion and confirmation with the relevant National Coach.

Flights are to leave Australia three days prior to the first day of athlete's competition; this may be varied to meet the competition organiser's requirements or AISL operational requirements.

Competitors will depart where possible on the day following their competition; however there will only be a maximum of three flights to and from an Event and this will primarily depend on airline costs and budget.

Competitors (squad or self funded) wishing to make alternate arrangements must first confirm this with the AISL National Head Coach.

1. If approved, then the athlete must make those travel arrangements and submit them to the office for final approval.
2. The office will send confirmation of acceptance to the athlete who must book and pay for those flights and send a copy of all arrangements to the AISL office.
3. Upon return squad athlete/s must submit a copy of the ticket and travel agents receipt.
4. AISL will then reimburse the athlete/s with the either the fare paid by the athlete/s or the equivalent of that which AISL would have paid (whichever is the lesser).
5. AISL will not be responsible for costs incurred through flight delays or transit arrangements and advise those who take this option to arrange their own travel insurance to cover any eventualities.

Self funding competitors who meet the requirements for reimbursement as per the table above will be notified by the AISL office of the amount they will receive which will be based on the amount AISL would have been charged.

***Any competitor who makes his own travel arrangements and fails to arrive in time for the official training day will not be reimbursed.***
