

AISL Website Protocol

This Protocol describes the conditions that will apply to any AISL approved link from your website to AISL's website. Please note that non-compliance with this Protocol may result in AISL's approval being withdrawn.

1. Website

You are only authorised to provide a link to AISL's website from a website wholly owned and controlled by you or your authorised agent which is approved in writing by AISL ("your website"). Should the internet address, ownership or control of your website change subsequent to AISL giving its approval, you must advise AISL of the change immediately.

You are authorised to provide a link only to AISL's homepage at <http://www.ausshooting.org>. If you wish to provide a link to any other area of AISL's website you must obtain prior written permission from the AISL.

The link from your website must open AISL's website in a separate browser window — that is it must not be framed by another website interface.

2. Form of link

You must not provide a link to AISL's website by any means other than a text link using the terms "Australian International Shooting Limited" or "AISL" ("AISL Name"). No other words or terms or abbreviations may be used.

3. Security

You must maintain hardware and software security measures on your website infrastructure and architecture in order to manage and prevent the downloading, storage and transmission of computer viruses, spyware, adware and other disruptive code and to prevent spam activity, on or from your website. In particular, you must maintain effective firewall protection and server security controls.

4. Content

The appearance of the AISL Name on your website may suggest that that AISL approves of the content and material on your website. Accordingly you must ensure that you do not represent or suggest in any way that AISL has approved of or endorsed your website and its content. You must also ensure that the content and material displayed on or accessed via your website maintains the integrity of AISL and does nothing to bring into disrepute or censure AISL, its officers, agents, employees or the sport of shooting in general.

AISL reserves its rights to terminate or suspend the operation of this Protocol under clause 10 if it believes that the content of your website does not comply at all times with accepted standards of public decency and good taste or contains or links to material that is unlawful, defamatory, pornographic or offensive. In particular AISL is concerned about matters that it believes promotes, condones or encourages inappropriate use of firearms or that disparages the sport of shooting.

5. Advertising

Subject to the terms of any specific sponsorship agreement with AISL, the AISL Name must not be attached to or be displayed in juxtaposition to any other emblem, logo, mark, advertising or material that appears on your website. In particular, the AISL Name must not be displayed in such a manner that would or could suggest that AISL has an association or affiliation with or endorses any commercial advertising or activity appearing on your website.

You must ensure that no pop-up advertising is attached to the link from your website to AISL's website.

6. Access

You must regularly monitor the link from your website to AISL's website to ensure that the link is fully functional at all times.

Should the link from your website to AISL's website fail, you must remove it from your website and only replace it when the link from your website to AISL's website has been repaired. The AISL will endeavour to promptly advise you of any change to the internet address of AISL's website, but is not obliged so to do.

7. Intellectual Property

The material on AISL's website is protected by copyright and you must not copy, frame, modify transmit or distribute any material from AISL's website without the prior written approval of AISL.

8. Monitoring

The AISL will monitor your use of the link and your website in general to ensure that this Protocol is complied with. You must ensure that the AISL is provided with any access codes or passwords required for full access to your website.

To assist AISL monitoring, you must advise AISL of the internet address of each page on your website on which the link appears. You must promptly advise AISL of any changes to these internet addresses.

9. Indemnity and Liability

You will indemnify and keep indemnified AISL from and against all claims, demands, actions, proceedings, costs and expenses (including legal costs calculated on a solicitor and client basis) and liability to third parties arising out of or incidental to your use of the AISL Name and the content of your website.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, you waive, release and discharge AISL from any liability it may have to you arising out of or in connection with your use of the AISL Name or your linkage to AISL's website including but not limited to liability for loss of profits, loss of revenue or loss of data.

10. Termination

AISL may withdraw its approval at any time and immediately suspend or terminate this Protocol, whether or not you have breached this Protocol. AISL will give you written notice of any such action and you must then immediately cease using the AISL Name and remove the link from your website to AISL's website.

This provision will not affect any rights to the contrary granted under specific agreements with AISL.

11. Protocol

AISL reserves the right to alter, modify or amend this Protocol at any time. Should it do so, it will endeavour to notify you of such change, however, it is your responsibility to check with AISL from time to time to ensure you are aware of and comply with any changes made.

This Protocol supersedes and overrides any representation or understanding (whether oral or written) made to you in relation to AISL's approval and overrides any terms or conditions contained on your website.

12. Governing Law

This Protocol and AISL's approval are governed by the laws of Victoria.
