### 4. Participation

- 4.1 The maximum number of shooters per federation/event will be three (3) and up to two (2) additional shooters per event for MQS.
- 4.2 The number of entries for team officials is not limited.
- 4.4 Please refer to attached registration forms for entry into this event.
- 4.5 Entries to the 50m Prone Rifle Women's Grand Prix event are limited to five competitors per country. This event is run by the Organising Committee and is therefore not a World Cup event.

### 5. Rules and Regulations

- 5.1 All competitions will be conducted under the current ISSF Rules and Regulations.
- 5.2 An MQS shooter may replace a withdrawn "Regular" (Quota Place) shooter. The withdrawn Regular Shooter may not shoot for MQS (3.7.3.7). In this World Cup where no Quota Places are available, the rules shall apply as if Quota Places were available.

### 6. Entry Process

- 6.1 Preliminary entries are to be made directly to ISSF by online registration at <http://entry.issf-sports.info> or fax by December 30<sup>th</sup> 2009.

- 6.2 Final entries must be made directly to ISSF by online registration or fax. The date for final entry is 30 days before the date of official arrival, and will be 18<sup>th</sup> February 2010. This information must include the names and ID numbers of all competitors. It should also include the names, dates of birth and official function of any officials.
- 6.3 Final hotel reservations and final rooming list must be completed by February 10<sup>th</sup> 2010.
- 6.4 Late entries as per ISSF Rules

## 7. The Range

- 7.1 The Sydney International Shooting Centre was built for the Sydney Olympic Games in 2000. It is situated to the west of Sydney, 50 km from the airport.
- 7.2 Light snacks, sandwiches, salads, fruit, drinks etc., will be available for competitors, officials and volunteers at the range.

## 8 Entry Visa

- 8.1 After receiving the Visa Support (Annex 7), the Organising Committee will provide the Federation with an Official Invitation from the Australian International Shooting Limited to assist those countries that are required to apply for their entry visas at the Australian Embassy or Consulate in their respective countries.
- 8.2 Federations that require entry visas to Australia are requested to contact their local Australian Consulate or Embassy.

## 9 Firearms

- 9.1 All competitors and team officials who may handle firearms must apply for a firearms licence. Junior competitors under the age of 18 years must also provide a copy of their current shooting permit and a letter from their parents supporting their application.
- 9.2 All Competitors will be required to fill out Annex 8 which is the "NSW Police Force – Firearms Registry Application for a (temporary) overseas competitor firearm permit P645" form. You will be required to supply a clear copy of your passport and own firearms licence if applicable –***NOTE FAXED COPIES OF PASSPORTS & FIREARMS LICENCES WILL NOT BE SUFFICIENT YOU WILL NEED TO SCAN AND EMAIL TO ORGANISING COMMITTEE OR SEND CLEAR COPY VIA POST.***
- 9.3 All air operated firearms, rifle and pistols including pellets, must have an import licence and must be declared on Annex 8 - "NSW Police Force – Firearms Registry Application for a (temporary) overseas competitor firearm permit P645".
- 9.4 All firearms must be secured at the official armoury upon arrival.
- 9.5 All Firearm & Ammunition forms must be returned to the Organising Committee by no later than **February 1<sup>st</sup> 2010** and must be accompanied by the appropriate fee of \$85.00 per person. Bank details are as per cl.23.2

## 10. Customs formalities

10.1 The firearm permit allows the firearm to come into Australia; however the Australian Customs service also needs to confirm all firearms imported are taken out of the country.

We will provide the federations further information once entries have been received.

## 11. Assistance upon arrival

11.1 Delegations will be met on arrival by a member of the organising committee to assist. Transport will take you to the armoury to deposit firearms and then to the hotel.

## 12. Accommodation

12.1 The Organizing Committee has arranged two official hotels for all the participating Federations. Both facilities include a choice of restaurants and food styles. Breakfast is included. The two Official Hotels are

**No payment to the ISSF or to the hotel – Payment must be made directly to Organising Committee.**

Rooms will be allocated to Teams on a first come, first served basis. The reservation can only be considered confirmed once the Final Hotel Reservation Form and Final Rooming list and the deposit of 50% of the total accommodation costs have been received by the Organizing Committee within the deadline (February 10<sup>th</sup> 2010).

*\*\*Please note these hotels will not take direct bookings, they will only take bookings from the Organizing Committee.*

All monies paid, must be net of any bank commission for the transfer of money. Any deposit balance caused by Telegraphic Transfer charge of the wiring or intermediate bank is the responsibility of the participants and must be paid by 20<sup>th</sup> March 2010.

The deadline for change and cancellation of hotel reservation is *February 10<sup>th</sup> 2010*. In case of cancellation or non-show after that date, the penalty fee will be equal to the cost for one night/ea.

**50% deposit to be transferred to our bank account, details under Section 23 "Contacts".**

## 13 Information on Range Equipment

- 13.1 The Shooting Range is equipped with equipment conforming to the ISSF Rules:
- 50m range-----60 firing points (SIUS ASCOR)
  - 10m range-----60 firing points (SIUS ASCOR)
  - 25m range-----8 Banks of 5 (SIUS ASCOR)
  - Finals range -----10 firing points in 10m, 25m & 50m (SIUS ASCOR)

## 14 Ammunition

- 14.1 Competitors may bring ammunition with them but should consider the limit which is permitted by the airlines.
- 14.2 A limited range of ammunition will be available for purchase on the range.
- 14.3 *Australian Customs will not allow any ammo to be taken on your return flight.*

## 15 Arms Storage

- 15.1 The firearms and ammunition brought by each participating team will be deposited at the shooting range armoury.

## 16 Fees

- 16.1 *Entry fees* EURO 170 per shooter /event
- 16.2 *Official's fee:* EURO 50 per person
- 16.3 *Firearms Permit:* AUD \$85 per permit (AUS. Firearms Regulation)
- 16.3 *Airport pick-up:* **Pick-up 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> March Only**  
*Airport Pick up charges AUD \$10 per person to be paid to Organising Committee*
- 16.4 *Official training* No charge
- 16.5 *Unofficial Training* If available and within the rules ranges may be available for use at \$25.00 per competitor per session.
- 16.6 *Airport Tax* Passengers of international airlines are reminded, where applicable, to pay the airport tax on departure at the Sydney International Airport.

## 17 Registration and method of payment

- 17.1 All participating teams must complete the registration for the final entry confirmation as well as the balance of any payment for the accommodation and entry fees to the Organizing Committee either by bank transfer prior to arrival or at the shooting range on March 20<sup>th</sup> 2010.
- 17.2 All cash payments may be made in Euro or Australian dollars at the rate published in the office.
- 17.3 Bank details for early transfer of funds are listed under item 23 "Contacts".

## 18. Local Transport

- 18.1 For those Participants who are in official accommodation at the two (2) official hotels, transport will be provided between these hotels and the shooting range. A timetable will be published prior to arrival.
- 18.2 There will be a pickup service from the Sydney International Airport to the Official Hotels upon arrival. Pick-up will only be available on the 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> March 2010. A departure service will also be available.

**PLEASE NOTE: Pick-up transport is only available on these dates (19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> March 2010). Outside of these dates may be on a commercial rate as charged by our transport company. Please advise Organizing Committee should you require.**

## 19. ISSF Identification (ID) No.

- 19.1 All entries must have an ISSF Number at the time of registration with the ISSF.

## 20 Doping Control

- 20.1 All doping control will be conducted in accordance with the ISSF Anti Doping Regulations by the Australia Sports Anti-Doping Agency, which is accredited with WADA.
- 20.2 Athletes and coaches are reminded that the ISSF must be advised in writing, and BEFORE the competition, of any medications taken by competitors, and that a copy of TUE must also be provided to the Organising Committee.

## 21 Ceremonies

- 21.1 Technical Meeting will take place at 1615 hours on 21<sup>st</sup> March 2010 on the Finals range
- 21.2 An Opening Ceremony will be conducted on the shooting range at approximately 1700 hours on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2010.
- 21.3 A Closing Dinner / BBQ will be held on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> March, provided there are enough people interested in attending. A cost and information sheet will be circulated to teams on arrival Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> March.

- 21.4 Award Ceremonies will be conducted in the Finals Range after each Finals match. Enough time will be allowed following each match for the winners to change into Official National Uniform or Official National Tracksuit as per ISSF rule 6.17.5.5.  
The Award Ceremony for the Grand Prix event will be conducted at the conclusion of the event following protest time.
- 21.5 Flags: All participating teams are required to bring with them three of their national flags (Minimum size: 1 m X 1.5m approx.), and one national anthem on standard cassette tape (40-50 seconds) or CD.

## 22. Climate

- 22.1 The mean daily maximum temperature in March in Sydney is 24 C and the mean daily minimum is 17 C. The average humidity is 74% and average rainfall in March is 122mm.

- 23.1 Limited on-site press facilities will be available and further details may be obtained via the organising committees email [events@ausshooting.org](mailto:events@ausshooting.org)
- 23.2 ISSF-TV – All finals will be covered through ISSF TV.
