

AISL Selection Policy: 2010 Commonwealth Shooting Federation Championship

The following is published to enable all to understand the process for Commonwealth Shooting Federation Championships Team Selection.

- a) the AISL Team to the 2010 Commonwealth Shooting Federation Championships in India will be selected from three Selection competitions for each discipline:

- b) Ranking will be determined by the aggregate of the two highest scores (without the Finals) from the Competitions listed above. Where there are two or more shooters with a tied score in Olympic events then the tie will be broken by a shoot off round conducted under ISSF finals conditions. In the unlikely event that a tie still exists then it will be broken by a miss and out shoot off under ISSF tie break rules. All shoot offs for team placing will be conducted prior to the final of the last selection competition. If two or more athletes have equal score in non Olympic events; then the tie will be broken by ISSF Rules.
- c) Those athletes **ranked in the top three** in each event will be considered for eligibility to be selected in the AISL Team for the Commonwealth Shooting Federation Championships provided they have achieved the Minimum Qualifying score for the Commonwealth Shooting Federation Championships (MQS CSFC) listed in j), at least once in the selection competitions listed above.
- d) If the team are not fully selected by cl. c), the AISL Selection Panel may in their absolute discretion nominate to the team, athletes from the AISL High Performance Squads even if they have not met the criteria listed in cl. c).
- e) the AISL Selection Panel may enter selected team members to compete in other events if allowed by the Commonwealth Shooting Federation Championships competitions rules.
- f) the AISL Team to the Commonwealth Shooting Federation Championships will be announced December 8, 2009.
- g) AISL will cover the costs of travel, accommodation, and entry fees for the AISL Team, subject to funding available. Team Size will be determined by available funding and this will be confirmed at the time of announcement of the team.
- h) AISL may decide to enter selected athletes on a part or self funding basis.
