

AISL Selection Criteria: Oceania Championships 2009

The following is published to enable all to understand the process for Oceania Team Selection.

1. The Oceania Team will be selected from the AISL Ranking List as published on the AISL website www.ausshooting.org
 - a) AISL will only enter events in which there will be a minimum 6 individuals from a minimum of 2 countries competing in the Oceania Championships.
 - b) Those athletes **ranked in the top nine** in each event will be eligible to be selected in the Oceania Team. The AISL Selection Panel will use its absolute discretion to allocate positions in the Teams (A,B or C) provided those athletes have achieved a Minimum Qualifying score for the Oceania Championships (MQSO) listed in cl.9, at least once in the period 19 Sep '08 – 20 Sep'09.
2. Where there are two or more shooters with a tied score then the tie will be broken by a shoot off round conducted under ISSF finals conditions. In the unlikely event that a tie still exists then it will be broken by a miss and out shoot off under ISSF tie break rules. All shoot offs for team placing will be conducted prior to the final of the last selection competition. If two or more athletes have equal score in non Olympic events; then the tie will be broken by ISSF Rules.
3. The AISL Selection Panel will select junior athletes.
4. If the AISL Selection Panel in their absolute discretion decides to enter junior athletes from the top nine ranked athletes on the AISL Ranking list into the junior team, then an invitation will be extend to the athlete ranked 10th, 11th etc on the AISL Ranking list.
5. The Oceania's are conducted under the ISSF rules and therefore in the Olympic events only five athletes may be nominated for Minimum Qualifying Score status. Accordingly the AISL selection panel will in its absolute discretion select, from those ranked in the top nine, five to be nominated for MQS.
6. The Oceania Team will be announced September 25, 2009.
7. AISL will fund the ISSF "A" team in Olympic events for travel, accommodation and entry fees
8. All travel, accommodation, and entry fees, etc) for the "B" and "C" teams and all non Olympic events will be on a self funding basis.
