Competition Information

1. Dates and Venue

1. The Oceania Shooting Federation 2011 Continental Championship will be held in Sydney, Australia from 26th of November – 1st of December 2011.
2. Quota places will be awarded as per ISSF regulations.

2. Events as listed in the attached program

1. All Olympic ISSF Shotgun, Pistol & Rifle—Teams and Individual.
2. Teams and Individual.
3. IMSSU both Individual and Team

3. Participation

1. The Oceania Continental Championship is open to officially entered teams.
2. Teams Event for A, B, C and Junior can only be entered by Oceania Countries
3. MQS will be available to Oceania Shooting Federations members only. A country may enter 3 Quota entries and 2 MSQ only entries with a maximum of 9 in each event (3 teams of 3)
4. The number of entries for team officials is not limited.
5. Grand Prix Event is open to all Individuals to enter.
6. Please refer to attached registration forms for entry into this event.
7. Entries for all other events are as per the OSF rule book 2008 version.
8. If no Junior event occurs in a match then they can enter as a Senior, this will not affect status in other Junior events.
9. Finals in all events will be open only to those in the A team, empty spots will not be filled, however should there be insufficient entries in a shotgun final, fillers may be used.
10. Time and light permitting finals may be organised for GP events.

4. Rules and Regulations

1. All competitions will be conducted under the current ISSF and OSF Rules and Regulations.
2. In the Skeet competition the official ISSF Skeet Tape must be affixed as per the rules.
3. The current ISSF rules regarding clothing and uniform will apply and be enforced.

5. Entry Process

1. The date for final entry will be October 14th 2011. 50% of the entry and accommodation fee will be due by the 14th of October. This information must include the names and ID numbers of all competitors. It should also include the name, date of birth and official function of any officials.

6. The Ranges

1. The Sydney International Shooting Centre was built for the Sydney Olympic Games in 2000. It is situated to the west of Sydney, 50 km from the airport.
2. Light snacks, sandwiches, salads, fruit, drinks etc, will be available for competitors, officials and volunteers at the range. Kemps Creek Bowling Club is a 5 minute drive.

7 Entry Visa

1. Federations that require entry visas to Australia are requested to contact their local Australian Consulate or Embassy. Please visit the Australian Department of Immigration and Citizenship website: <http://www.immi.gov.au/>

8 Firearms

1. All competitors and team officials who may handle firearms must apply for a firearms licence.
2. Junior competitors under the age of 18 years must also provide a copy of their current shooting permit and a letter from their parents supporting their application.
3. ***All air operated firearms, rifle and pistols including pellets, must also have an import licence and must be declared***
4. All firearms must be secured at the official armoury upon arrival.

9. Customs formalities

1. The firearm permit allows the firearm to come into Australia; however the Australian Customs service also needs to confirm all firearms imported are taken out of the country. The customs departure form will be posted on the AISL website www.ausshooting.org/oceania and available at registration.
2. Assistance in completing these will be available on the range. (there is no charge)

10. Accommodation

A list of hotels recommended by Australian International Shooting Ltd (AISL) is shown as Appendix A, please contact them direct to arrange your accommodation.

13. Information on Range Equipment

1. The SISC Range is equipped with equipment conforming to the ISSF Rules:
 - 50m range ----- 60 firing points (SIUS ASCOR)
 - 10m range ----- 60 firing points (SIUS ASCOR)
 - 25m range ----- 10 groups of targets (SIUS ASCOR)
 - Finals range ----- 50m, 25m, 10m (SIUS ASCOR)
2. --The 3 Shotgun ranges comprise Olympic Trap and Skeet layouts equipped with Matarelli machines.
3. --IMSSU range is the Sporting Shooters Majura Range.

14. Ammunition & Arms Storage

1. Competitors may bring ammunition with them but should consider the limit which is permitted by the airlines.
2. A limited range of ammunition will be available for purchase on the range; if you have a preference please advise and we can generally place on order.
3. The firearms and ammunition brought by each participating team will be deposited at the shooting range armoury.

15. Fees

<i>Entry fees all Events</i>	AUD \$240 per shooter /event
Grand Prix entry	AUD \$80 per event
<i>Official's fee:</i>	AUD \$100 per official
<i>Team Entry fee:</i>	AUD \$100 per team/ event – there are no teams events in Grand Prix.
<i>Shotgun Training Fees:</i>	AUD\$7.00 per round Trap and Skeet and AUD\$14.00 for Double Trap
<i>Firearms Permit:</i>	AUD\$85 per permit (AUS. Firearms Regulation)
<i>Official training for Championship</i>	No charge – 1 round only.
<i>Unofficial Training</i>	If available and within the rules ranges may be available for use at the fee set by the range management.

16. Registration and method of payment

1. 50% Deposit of entry fees needs to be paid to organising committee by 14th October 2011.
2. All participating teams must complete the registration for the final entry confirmation as well as the balance of any payment for the entry fees to the Organizing Committee either by bank transfer prior to arrival, or at the shooting range by 10:00am on November 27th 2011. All cash payments may be made in Australian Dollars. Bank details for early transfer of funds are listed under item 25 "Contacts".

17. Local Transport

There will be no official transport. A list of car companies that AISL recommends is shown on Appendix B for you to hire.

18. ISSF Identification (ID) No.

Where applicable all ISSF entries must have an ISSF Number at the time of registration.

19. Doping Control

1. All doping control will be conducted in accordance with the relevant IF Anti Doping Regulations by the Australia Sports Anti-Doping Agency, which is accredited with the WADA.
2. Athletes and coaches are reminded that the IF must be advised in writing, and BEFORE the competition, of any medications taken by competitors, and that a copy of the approved TUE must also be provided to the Organising Committee.

20. Ceremonies / Meetings

1. Technical Meeting will take place at 2.00pm on the 27th of November on the Finals range at SISC
2. Executive Meeting will take place on the 28th November at 4.30pm.
3. General Meeting will take place on the 30th November at 4.30pm.
4. Award Ceremonies will be conducted 15 minutes after the conclusion of the finals. Entrants are reminded that Official National Uniform or Official National Tracksuit must be worn at the presentation.
5. The Award Ceremony for the Grand Prix events will be conducted at the conclusion of the match following protest time.
6. Flags: All participating teams are required to bring with them two of their national flags (Minimum size: 1 m X 1.5m approx.), and one national anthem on standard cassette tape (40-50 seconds) or CD for the Opening Ceremony and Victory Ceremony.

21. Climate

The mean daily maximum temperature in November - December in Sydney is between around 25C and the mean daily minimum is 14 C. The average rainfall is 78mm for the month. Sunshine hours are 8 and days of sunshine are 20. (Generally this adds up to good weather)
